

PLANNING A NEW INTERACTION MECHANISM OF SUBJECTS OF INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE SOCIAL GUARANTEES

In this article, the theoretical bases of institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties in the national economy, including the economic substance of state social guaranties, the content of institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties, and the mechanism of interaction of institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties are explored.

The mechanism of institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties is carried out in three main areas: income, education and health. When the state removes in the economically active population a part of their income, then it invest in its development in the form of free services of education, health care, cultural services, social security. It is proved that under the institutional support an implementation of social guarantees of the state should be understood as a set of public and private institutions that ensure the implementation

of existing legal, institutional and economic conditions for the formation of the security and development of economy and society that need improving its activities in the European integration.

The directions of transforming the institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties in the national economy on the basis of decentralization and public control over the quality of social services are improved. The structure and principles of transformation of institutional support for the implementation of state social guaranties are proved. During the development and provision of state social guarantees, using the tools of social audit and participatory budget, were offered.
