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# STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF EDUCATION IN UKRAINE

# СТРАТЕГІЧНІ НАПРЯМКИ РОЗВИТКУ ОСВІТИ В УКРАЇНІ

By addressing these issues, the study seeks to provide actionable recommendations for policymakers, educational institutions, and stakeholders to enhance the resilience, effectiveness, and competitiveness of Ukraine's education system in an increasingly complex and interconnected world.

Analysis of recent scientific research. Recent studies [1; 4] on the development of the education sector in Ukraine emphasize the critical need for strategic reforms and innovations to enhance the sector's responsiveness to global challenges. The rapid advancement of digital technologies, globalization of educational standards, and the increasing role of knowledge-based economies have forced educational institutions to adapt to a new reality. Studies show a growing mismatch between the skills taught in higher education institutions and the qualifications required by employers, leading to high levels of graduate

unemployment. Researchers argue for the modernization of curricula, the introduction of practical and vocational training, and stronger collaboration between educational institutions and businesses to bridge this gap.

The ongoing socio-political crisis in Ukraine, particularly due to the war and its impact on the country's stability, has also been a focal point of recent academic inquiries. Many studies [6] investigate how educational institutions can develop resilience and adaptability in times of crisis. The need for crisis management strategies, as well as educational policies that can respond effectively to unforeseen disruptions, is widely recognized. Scholars [5] advocate for the development of flexible educational models that ensure continuity of learning during crises, emphasizing online learning as a key component of such models.

Moreover, scientific research in the field of education stresses the role of international cooperation and knowledge exchange. Collaboration with international partners, including European and global educational institutions, has been identified as crucial for advancing Ukrainian education standards. Recent research [3] suggests that adopting best practices from leading global educational systems and engaging in international research projects can help Ukrainian institutions improve their competitiveness and adapt to global trends in education.

The aim of the research. The primary aim of this research is to develop a comprehensive set of strategic directions for the sustainable and innovative development of Ukraine's education sector. The study seeks to identify key priorities and actionable strategies that can enhance the sector's adaptability to global challenges, particularly focusing on the integration of digital technologies, curriculum modernization, and the alignment of educational programs with labor market demands. Additionally, the research aims to address the growing need for crisis management mechanisms in the educational system, ensuring its resilience during periods of socio-political instability and other external disruptions.

By analyzing the current state of education in Ukraine, the research will propose recommendations for policy reforms and institutional changes that promote quality education, accessibility, and global competitiveness. Another central aim is to explore opportunities for international collaboration, emphasizing the importance of aligning Ukrainian educational standards with global practices to enhance the country's participation in the global educational landscape.

Presentation of the main research material.
